

**Win a Peregrine Writing Workshop with Ransom Riggs Contest
OFFICIAL RULES**

IMPORTANT: Please read these Official Rules before entering the **Win a Peregrine Writing Workshop with Ransom Riggs Contest** (the “Contest”), presented by **Penguin Young Readers Group**, a division of Penguin Random House LLC (“Sponsor”). By entering the Contest, you agree to the terms of these Official Rules. These Official Rules shall govern in the event of any inconsistency with other Contest-related materials.

NO PURCHASE NECESSARY TO ENTER OR WIN.

ELIGIBILITY: The Contest is open to residents of the fifty (50) United States and the District of Columbia, who are 13 - 18 years of age at time of entry. All federal, state, and local regulations apply. **LIMIT ONE ENTRY PER PERSON. VOID WHERE PROHIBITED OR RESTRICTED.** Employees of Sponsor its parents, subsidiaries, affiliates, suppliers, and agencies, and their immediate family members and persons living in their household are not eligible to enter the Contest.

ENTRY PERIOD: The Contest begins at 12:01 AM (EST) on August 1, 2018, and ends at 11:59 PM (EST) on December 31, 2018.

HOW TO ENTER: To enter the contest, visit the contest website at www.peculiarwriting.com and submit the online entry form along with your student’s or library patron’s original 500 – 1000 word story inspired by the world of Ransom Riggs MISS PEREGRINE series. Entry can include photos but must be an original work about a new character, setting, or loop. The entry form must include the following information: the first name of entrant, the entrants’s grade, librarian/teacher’s first and last name, school/library name, school/library address and contact information (email and telephone number). By entering the Contest, entrants represent and warrant that the entries are their own and original creations, and do not violate or infringe the rights, including, without limitation, copyrights, trademark rights or rights of publicity/privacy, of any third party.

In the event of a dispute, entries will be deemed made by the authorized account holder of the email address used for entry. Automated entries are prohibited, and any use of automated devices will result in disqualification. Sponsor is not responsible for incorrect or inaccurate entry of information by entrants; lost or late entries or transmissions; interrupted or unavailable network, server, or other connections; scrambled transmissions or other errors or problems of any kind whether mechanical, human, or electronic, technical malfunctions of any computer hardware, software, or any combinations thereof; or problems associated with any virus or any other

damage caused to entrants' systems. Incomplete or illegible entries will be voided. All entries become the property of Sponsor and will not be returned. Submissions including photographs may not include obscene, offensive or inappropriate (in Sponsor's sole and absolute discretion) material or defame any person, or otherwise infringe on any person's proprietary rights. If you are submitting a photograph, you must have permission from the photographer (or be the photographer yourself) and have permission from any persons who appear in the photo before submitting it.

PRIVACY POLICY: All information submitted in connection with entry to this Contest shall be governed by Sponsor's privacy policy (at <http://www.penguinrandomhouse.com/privacy/>). By entering this Contest, you acknowledge that you have read and agree to this privacy policy.

PRIZE:

One (1) Grand Prize Winner(s) will receive (i) a visit from Ransom Riggs to the winner's school or library for a writing workshop and (ii) one (1) book for each student/patron attending the workshop up to 300 patrons. (Grand Prize Approximate Retail Value: \$5,000)

Four (4) Runner-Up Winner(s) will each receive (i) twenty (20) signed copies of *A Map of Days* by Ransom Riggs. (Runner-Up Prize Approximate Retail Value: \$460 per runner-up)

Workshop grand prize must be redeemed by May 31, 2019. Workshop will occur at mutually convenient times at the sole and absolute discretion of the Sponsor. By entering the Sweepstakes, librarian/teacher agrees to host the workshop if one of their patron/student entries is selected as the winner.

No transfer or cash or other substitution of all or part of a prize is permitted, except by Sponsor, which reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to substitute the prize or prize component with another of comparable or greater value. Any and all taxes on the prize will be the responsibility of the winners. JUDGING/WINNER SELECTION: **One (1) Grand Prize Winner(s) and four (4) Runner-Up Winners** will be selected by Penguin Young Readers staff and Ransom Riggs on or about February 1, 2019 from all eligible entries received by the entry deadline. Entries will be judged on clarity of writing, originality, and creativity, with equal weight being given to each criterion. The decisions of the Sponsor with respect to the selection of the winners, and in regard to all matter relating to this Contest, shall be final and binding. Winners will be notified via email and

must respond to email notification within ten (10) days of receipt. Winners (and Winners' parent or legal guardian if winner is a minor) may also be required to complete, execute and return an Affidavit of Eligibility and Release. Noncompliance with these conditions may result in forfeiture of the Prize, and Sponsor reserves the right to select alternate winners (in random drawing from other eligible entries received before the deadline) in such circumstance.
